Sorting helps children develop EXECUTIVE FUNCTION SKILLS, which is an important brain skills that help with memory, attention and problem-solving. Research shows that the stronger these skills are when a child begins kindergarten, the more likely they are to perform better at school. Executive function skills do not develop on their own, children need to participate in activities that promote these skills.

To nurture these skills, In math we performed an activity by sorting the beads and toys according to its color. Children were very enthusiastic in doing such activity of sorting objects with its colors. They were eager to finish their favorite color first and managed time limits given for the activity.

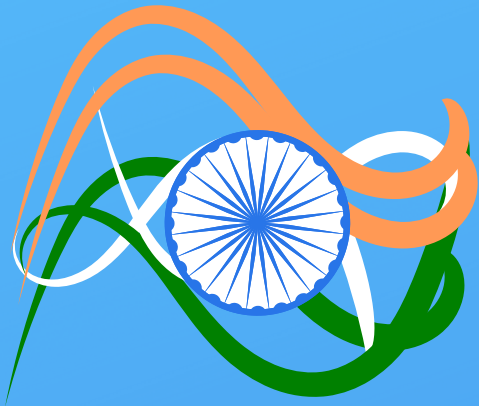
