Our inquisitive learners were excited to learn and observe the different weather different conditions and also make necessary decisions regarding their everyday life accordingly.



Pocket Phonics

Our children never missed out to enrich their literacy skill ,through each participation like identifying sight words, letter sound & reading them aloud. They were eager to step out to show their independency in putting up letter sounds together & coming up with words by themselves.

Their initiative in reading decodable book showed that they are simply the risk takers to develop their skills. Students showed active participation in doing activities related to phonics, they were knowledgeable in identifying letter sound & matching them with their correct family words. Developing knowledge on phonics always made our kids improve their reading skill.

Playing in the water is always appealing to children and swimming combines fun and learning.
